The Vision Dixie Implementation Committee will be introducing the Vision Dixie Principles to the cities of Hurricane, La Verkin and Toquerville at **5pm on Tuesday, February 19th at the Hurricane City Council Chambers**. At this informal work meeting, it is the hope of the Committee to initiate a dialogue with and among the cities to determine their interest in incorporating the Vision Dixie Principles and how the Implementation Committee can best serve as a resource to each city going forward.

The public is not only invited, but highly encouraged, to attend. Vision Dixie is a historic effort by leaders throughout Washington County to build a vision for tomorrow based on the ideas and values of local residents. Led by the Washington County Commission in partnership with numerous public and private entities, over 3,000 residents created a framework in which future development and transportation work together to create communities and a region that preserves Southern Utah's quality of life, along with an affordable, livable future.
